would be nice to be able to add individual map layers to a program like

Google Earth

Tools to Use: The Data Dictionary, Google Earth

Instructions: Go to the Data Dictionary on the MBCDP web-site and navigate to the map

layer of interest. At the bottom of the data documentation tab is a link to download KMZ versions of each map layer. These are formatted with symbology and attribute pop-ups so they can be used directly in

Google Earth.
