

Food Banks (Winnipeg Harvest) - locations randomized within neighborhoods **Community Gardens** - administered by the City of Winnipeg

FOOD & NUTRITION INSECURITY INDICATORS

Food Insecurity Measures

- Household Food Desert: individuals in low-income households > 500 meters from either a Full Service or National Chain Grocery Store (updating in progress)
- <u>Neighborhood Food Desert</u>: individuals living in a low income dissemination area (income quintile 1) > 500 meters from either a Full Service or National Chain Grocery Store (data is dated, based on 2011 Census data and 2015

Nutrition Insecurity Measures

- Diabetes Prevalence Cases* 35-49 yr olds
- Diabetes Prevalence Rates* (cases/100) and costs by Neighborhood
- Diabetes Prevalence Rates* (cases/100) and costs by Electoral Ward
